

## INVESTMENTS VS EXPENSES

**State Spending vs. School Spending**Average Growth Per Year: Between 2010 and 2024

State Budget 3.22% Average Growth Per Year

Total School "Disbursements" 3.26% Average Growth Per Year

Cost Per Student Average Growth: 3.08%
Statewide, school spending tracks right around State spending

Total School Disbursements 2010 = \$3.07 Billion 2024 = \$4.99 Billion


> Total State Budget 2010 = \$3.33 Billion 2024 = \$5.35 Billion

If aid to local government was the same as 20 years ago, an additional \$331 million would be available for property tax relief.

## **Percent Invested in Classroom**

Nebraska outranks all neighboring states with the % of dollars going straight to the classroom





## **Cost Per Student**

With a range of \$12,005 (South Dakota) to \$19,324 (Wyoming), Nebraska is in the middle of Cost Per Student for surrounding states at \$15,200, and below the national average of \$16,526

Nebraska has the 6th highest percentage of total cost per student being invested in "instruction"

Nebraska ranks 26th for lowest percentage of total funding going into administration - both general administration and school administration
